What is EDGAR Next?

- EDGAR Next is the SEC's initiative to modernize filer access and account management on the EDGAR system.
- Designed to enhance security, transparency, and ease of use for filers.
- Key features:
 - Centralized account management
 - Stronger authentication using Login.gov
 - Streamlines access for authorized individuals

Why is the SEC moving toward EDGAR Next?

Security Improvements:

- Reduces risks associated with legacy login credentials.
- Enhances protection against unauthorized access and cyber threats.

Efficiency & Transparency:

- Simplifies account management for filers.
- Ensures better tracking of authorized users.

Regulatory Compliance:

 Aligns the EDGAR System with modern cybersecurity and authentication standards.



Background

- 2021 SEC announced plans for technical/workflow updates to EDGAR
 - Requested Public Comment
 - Account Management Improvement
 - Filer Access & Security
 - RDG Filings participated in those early calls
- 2024 SEC adopted EDGAR Next
 - Leverages Login.gov for User Authentication (MFA)
 - Security Updates
 - Redesign of the EDGAR Management Dashboard
 - Introduction of Company User Roles
 - Introduction of Delegation



Who will be affected by EDGAR Next?

- Every active filer, Over 200,000 Active CIK's
- Public companies, investment funds, reporting owners and other EDGAR filers.
- CFOs, Controllers, SEC Reporting Managers, and Compliance Officers.
- Filing Agent & Legal professionals that manage SEC filings.
- Any individuals needing access to EDGAR filing accounts.



Roles & Delegation

- Roles Filing Entities (Companies & Reporting Owners) can now assign account users to various roles within their EDGAR Account to manage various aspects of the company account:
 - Account Administrator (Up to 20)
 - User (Unlimited)
 - Technical Administrator (Up to 20)
- **Delegation** Filing Entities (Companies & Reporting Owners) can now delegate filing privileges to others in order to file on their behalf:
 - Filing Agents
 - Attorneys
 - Etc



Account Admin Role

- Account Management: They oversee the filer's EDGAR account through the new EDGAR Filer
 Management dashboard, including adding and removing users, technical administrators, and other
 account administrators.
- Submissions: They can make submissions on EDGAR using the filer's CIK & CCC.
- Filing Authority: Account administrators can delegate authority to file to other EDGAR accounts.
- **Annual Confirmation:** They are responsible for performing annual confirmations to ensure the accuracy of the filer's information on the dashboard.
- CCC Generation: They can generate or create CCCs (CIK Confirmation Codes).
- Reporting Owners Must Have 1 (Companies Must Have 2, can be the same as Technical Admins)
- Can have up to 20



Technical Admin Role

- **API Token Management:** They are authorized to create, manage, and deactivate filing tokens, which are used for authentication and authorization within the EDGAR system.
- Reporting Owners Must Have 1 (Companies Must Have 2, can be the same as Technical Admins)
- Can have up to 20



User Role

- Individuals who make EDGAR submissions.
- Unlimited



Delegated Entity

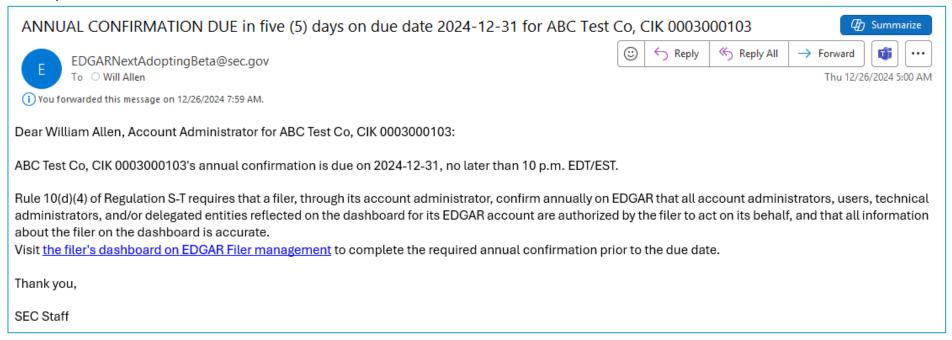
- Other entities with their own EDGAR accounts, such as filing agents, attorneys, etc. who are granted authority to file on behalf of the filer.
- RDG Filings will need to be delegated permission in order to file on your behalf once EDGAR Next has been fully rolled out.



Annual Confirmation

Account Admins are responsible for the Annual Confirmation

Important Information

- EDGAR Legacy Current EDGAR System
- EDGAR Next Future EDGAR System, Enrollment Began on March 24, 2025.
- These systems will **overlap for 6 months** so filers have time to enroll in EDGAR Next. We can still file via EDGAR Legacy until September 12, 2025.



SEC's Timeline for EDGAR Next

PREPARE

BETA OPENS

September 30, 2024

Prepare for EDGAR Next changes

- Individuals authorized by filers obtain Login.gov credentials using the email address they plan to use for EDGAR. Credentials will be needed for beta testing, enrollment, and compliance.
- Filers test in Adopting Beta. If planning to connect to optional APIs, filers develop API connections and adjust their filing applications.
- Filers gather CIK, CCC, and passphrase; identify whom they will authorize as account administrators, and, if connecting to optional APIs, technical administrators (unless using API connections of delegated entity); if planning to delegate authority to file, contact potential delegated entities.
- > Beta remains open until at least December 19, 2025.

ENROLL

DASHBOARD GOES LIVE

March 24, 2025

Existing filers: Enroll
Applicants for access: Submit
amended Form ID

- Enrollment opens March 24, 2025, on the dashboard of the new EDGAR Filer Management website.
- Filers have 6 months to enroll before compliance is required and an additional 3 months to enroll thereafter.
- Applicants for EDGAR access (prospective new filers and existing filers who do not have information needed to enroll) must complete and submit amended Form ID on dashboard.
- Option for enrolled filers and filers granted access on amended Form ID to file through submission API and use other APIs starting March 24, 2025.
- All other filers continue filing on EDGAR filing websites per existing process through September 12, 2025.

COMPLY

COMPLIANCE REQUIRED

September 15, 2025

Filers must comply with EDGAR
Next changes to file on EDGAR

- To make submissions, filers must be enrolled in EDGAR Next or granted access on amended Form ID.
- Login.gov credentials and completion of multifactor authentication required for login to all EDGAR websites.
- Existing filers may continue to enroll until December 19, 2025, but will not be able to file until they enroll.
- > Filers can no longer file on EDGAR using legacy codes.
- Enrollment ends December 19, 2025. After this date, submission of amended Form ID required to request access to existing accounts.

Renewal Frequency:

Filer Token (Entity) – 365 Days User Token (Individual) – 30 Days

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Preparing for EDGAR Next

Extremely Important - Filers need to obtain the following in order to enroll for EDGAR Next:

- CIK of Reporting Owner
- CCC (Newer than 2019)
- Passphrase (Newer than 2019)
 - <u>How do I obtain a new Passphrase?</u> The quickest and easiest way to reset the passphrase is by submitting a request to the EDGAR Next System to send a security token to the filer's EDGAR point of contact (POC) email address.

- RDG Can Help! Contact us for assistance Updating your Passphrase will also update your EDGAR Access Codes (CCC, password, PMAC) so you'll want to coordinate that with RDG to avoid any Filing Day issues.
- After Sept 12th Filers will NOT be able to file on EDGAR Legacy.



EDGAR Next Enrollment

- Confirm CIK
- Confirm CCC, and it is current
- Confirm Passphrase, and it is current
- Designate an Account Administrator
- Determine the EDGAR CIK annual confirmation date
 - (Mar. 31, Jun. 30, Sept. 30, or Dec. 31)
- Invite Account Administrators and Users to join the Entity Account
 - They will need to register with Login.gov to access the EDGAR Next Dashboard
- Delegate filing authority to RDG Filings

RDG Filings – Account Admin

Consider adding RDG Filings as an Account Administrator

Benefits:

- Company account must have at least two Account Administrators
- EDGAR Next requires company Account Admins to perform annual confirmation
- If Account Administrators leave your organization or are on leave when EDGAR account needs attention – Good idea to have a back up
- RDG can enroll your entity in EDGAR Next
- RDG Filings charges \$100 to serve as Account Admin for your company with EDGAR Next
